We have reviewed Arkansas's State Plan Amendment (SPA) 04-04 submitted to the Dallas Regional Office on August 31, 2004. This SPA provides for the use of a new single-state Medicaid supplemental rebate agreement (SRA) and an evidence-based preferred drug list (PDL). We have determined that the SPA, PDL and SRA are consistent with the objectives of the Medicaid program. Based on the information provided, we are pleased to inform you that Arkansas SPA 04-04 is approved, effective October 15, 2004

Approval of SPA 04-04 extends only to the SRA that was submitted to CMS on November 16, 2004, which is specifically referenced in the SPA. If changes are subsequently made to that drug rebate agreement, a new SPA and the revised agreement should be submitted to CMS for review and approval.
